# **Key Services:**

- Life skills training is provided through Cognitive Behavior Training.
- Initial Program Plan & Goals
- Individual and group job readiness.
- Employment assistance and training includes resume writing, job search strategies, application assistance and interview techniques.
- All residents are required to obtain identification and secure employment.
- Residents with extensive substance abuse and mental health issues will be referred to Mental Health Center.
- Sex Offender Treatment Program (SOTP) classes held on-site for those with parole stipulation.
- Cell phone privileges if approved through proper channels.
- Non-smoking facility.
- Resident kept vegetable garden and exterior landscape.
- Resident based orderly crew who assist with everyday maintenance and tasks.
- Education on chemical and safety training and orientation.
- Alcohol and Narcotic Anonymous classes that include 12-step program, Overcomers Recovery and Support, and Winner's Circle.
- Open-Door Policy indicating openness to any resident questions or concerns.
- The City of Edinburg is fare-free until 2020.
- Faith-Based classes and Bible Study.
- Food and Nutrition Classes.
- Education on Heat and Cold Related Injury.
- Education on HIV/AIDS, K2 and Emergency Action Plan.
- Quarterly Urine Analysis.
- Weekend Visitation is encouraged for Family.

#### **Amenities:**

- Air-Conditioned Facility and Vehicles.
- Transportation vehicles.
- Resident Parking for approved vehicles.
- Bicycle rack under surveillance.
- Day areas furnished with sitting area, coffee pots, board games and TV.
- Library equipped with an assortment of literature.
- Full-service laundry.
- Wheelchair and Disability Accessible.
- CapTel Captioned Telephone with Large Touchscreen and Amplification for Blind and Visually Impaired.
- Male and Female recreational area equipped with canopy, basketball court, volleyball court, track, and exercise equipment.
- Hydration water stations.
- Three (3) nutritious meals a day, on a 2,000 Cal scale, approved by licensed dietician.
- Meal accommodations for Religious Symbolism or Practices and/or Medical Reasons.
- Quarterly Resident Appreciation Day.
- Indigent Supplies; writing supplies, hygiene, clothes and postage.
- Sanitation Centralized Areas.
- Chow hall with available vending machines and microwaves.
